

ORDINANCE NO. 1-70

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS PUBLIC ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO BE KNOWN AS SHORT STREET, PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE, SOUTH AVENUE, AND PART OF CALIFORNIA AVENUE IN THE AREA OF THE TOWNSHIP KNOWN AS ORCHARD HILLS IN THE J. I. KNEP-SHIELD LOT PLAN AND THE R. R. SHELLHAMMER LOT PLAN.

The Township of Kiskiminetas hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The roads and streets, or parts thereof, hereinafter described, are hereby laid out, opened and ordained as public streets in the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania:

All of Short Street, all of Pennsylvania Avenue, and the remaining portion of South Avenue from Pennsylvania Avenue to Florida Avenue in the R. R. Shellhammer Plan of Lots of Orchard Hills; and that portion of California Avenue which runs from the new State Highway Route No. 56 to the old State Highway Route No. 56 in the J. I. Knepshield Plan of Lots of Orchard Hills. All of said streets shall be forty (40) feet in width.

SECTION 2. All of these streets, roads and parts thereof shall become a part of the road system of the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to a petition filed by the property owners abutting said streets, roads, or parts thereof, and pursuant to a public hearing held by the Supervisors, and in the judgment of the Supervisors the above roads are necessary for the public convenience.

SECTION 4. Any ordinance or parts of any ordinance inconsistent herewith are hereby

repealed.
