

ORDINANCE 1-72

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS PUBLIC STREETS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, STREETS COMPLETELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID TOWNSHIP, BEING KNOWN AS EVERGREEN WAY AND MAPLE DRIVE IN THE DEERWOOD MANOR PLAN OF LOTS, AS PART OF THE STREET AND ROAD SYSTEM OF SAID TOWNSHIP.

The Township of Kiskiminetas hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The following described streets are hereby laid out, opened and ordained as public streets in the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania:

EVERGREEN WAY. A street fifty (50) feet in width, beginning at the north line of State Highway Route No. 56 and running in a northerly and then a northeasterly direction for a distance of 1200 feet, more or less, to the south line of Cherry Way.

MAPLE DRIVE. A street fifty (50) feet in width, intersecting with Evergreen Way and running in a westerly direction for a distance of 1100 feet, more or less, ending in a cul de sac.

Both streets more fully depicted on the Plan of Lots of Deerwood Manor, recorded in Armstrong County Plan Book Volume 3, Pages 126-127, a copy being attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to a petition filed by the property owners abutting said streets and in the judgment of the Supervisors said streets are necessary in the interest of public convenience.

SECTION 3. The said streets are completely within the boundary limits of said Township and shall become a part of the system of streets and roads of said Township.
