

ORDINANCE NO. 1 -73

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3-51, PROHIBITING THE ERECTION, CREATION OR MAINTENANCE OF NUISANCES IN OR UPON ANY PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, OR UPON PRIVATE PROPERTY SUFFICIENTLY NEAR TO ANY SUCH HIGHWAY, TO EXUDE OR GIVE OFF NOXIOUS FUMES OR ODORS DETRIMENTAL TO HEALTH OR OBNOXIOUS TO THE TRAVELING PUBLIC OR NEARBY RESIDENTS, AMENDED TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3-51 of the Township of Kiskiminetas, enacted by the Board of Supervisors on August 11, 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Any person or persons offending against or violating the provisions hereof, upon conviction in a summary proceeding before any District Magistrate of the County of Armstrong, shall be subject to a fine or penalty of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each offense; and upon default made in the payment of such penalty so imposed, together with costs, may be imprisoned in the County jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days."

SECTION 2. Except as herein amended, said Ordinance No. 3-51 shall remain in full force and effect.
