

ORDINANCE NO. J-75

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF ROADS WHOLLY WITHIN
KISKIMINETAS TOWNSHIP, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

The Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township hereby enact and ordain as follows:

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, in the interest of public convenience, the following described portions of roads, being useless, burdensome and unnecessary for public convenience, be and the same are hereby vacated:

(a) That portion of Evergreen Way beginning at the intersection of Maple Drive and extending in a Northeasterly direction to Cherry Way for a distance of approximately 416 feet, said portion of Evergreen Way being 50 feet in width, and said street being in the Deerwood Manor Plan of Lots as recorded in Armstrong County Plan Book Volume 3, Pages 126 and 127.

(b) Approximately 0.7 miles of Township Road No. 323 from Legislative Route No. 03097 Southward for approximately 0.2 miles to State Route No. 56, and continuing South, Southeast for approximately 0.5 miles to Old State Route No. 56, said road being 33 feet or more in width.

Section 2. Said portions of roads to be abandoned as set forth in Section 1 are outlined in red upon a map or drawing which is on file with the Township Secretary, where it may be examined by any interested party, and which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. That the Township Solicitor, on behalf of the Supervisors, shall give at least ten (10) days written notice to all property owners effected by the vacation of said roads, that a hearing will be held by the Supervisors at the regular meeting to be held on Monday, January 3, 1975, at the Kiskiminetas Township Fire Hall, at 8:00 P.M.

Section 4. That following the passage of this Ordinance, the Solicitor of the Township is hereby directed to file a true and correct copy hereof, together with a draft or map of the roads

to be vacated, outlined in red, in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, to be filed in the Miscellaneous Docket, and thereafter any citizen or freeholder of the Township may file exceptions as provided by law.

Section 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
