

ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 82

"AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING A CERTAIN ROAD OR STREET COMPLETELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF KISKIMINETAS TOWNSHIP, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS PART OF THE STREET AND ROAD SYSTEM OF SAID TOWNSHIP."

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township has received a petition from all of the owners of properties abutting the road hereinafter set forth, requesting the said Supervisors to take over and adopt said road into the Township system;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The following described street or road is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street and road in the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania:

a. Being that certain strip of ground, a total of 50.0 feet wide, extending 25.0 feet on each side of the herein described centerline, situate in the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania. Beginning at the western end of 4th Street, (also known as T-676) as the same is shown on the Miller Plan of Lots in the Village of Spring Church as the same is recorded in Armstrong County Plan Book Volume 2, page 151 said point being 528' West of

the intersection of 4th Street and Clark Avenue as shown on said plan; thence extending said 4th Street for a further distance of 270' west and ending in a cul-de-sac with the centerline of said extension following the same direction as the centerline of the existing roadway.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is adopted pursuant to a petition filed by all the property owners abutting said street or road, and in the judgment of the Supervisors, the adoption of said street or road as part of the street and road system of the said Township is necessary in the interest of public convenience.

SECTION 3: The said street or road is completely within the boundary limits of Kiskiminetas Township and the same shall become a part of the system of streets and roads of said Township.

SECTION 4: A certified copy of this ordinance, together with a release of damages signed by all abutting property owners and a survey or draft of said road shall be filed in the Office of the Prothonotary of Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and indexed in the miscellaneous docket.

SECTION 5: In the event that the said road is not accepted as part of the Township road system by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, the Board of Supervisors will begin proceedings to vacate said road.
