

ORDINANCE NO. 1-85

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CONTROLLING TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME.

WHEREAS, in order to protect the lives and property of the citizens of the Township and the general public; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the Township road hereinafter; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, have found it necessary to control traffic through and parking on certain Township roads,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of same:

Section 1: After proper official signs have been placed, as hereinafter provided, no person shall stop, park or stand any vehicle whether attended or unattended, upon the roadway or berm of the roadway on the Southwest side of LR 03042 (Kiski Avenue Extension) from station marker 0/55 to 0/60, a distance of 175 feet.

Section 2: After proper signs have been placed, as hereinafter provided, no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour on TR-486 (Florida Avenue) between LR188 (Pennsylvania Route 56) and LR03097 (Sugar Hollow Road).

Section 3: After proper signs have been placed, as hereinafter provided, no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour on TR-319 (Highland Avenue) between Warren Avenue and Riverview Cemetery.

Section 4: The proper Township authorities are hereby directed to place official signs notifying the travelling public of the foregoing restrictions.

Section 5: All definitions used in this ordinance shall be the same as those definitions set forth in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81, effective 1 July 1977, as amended.

Section 6: Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than FIFTEEN (\$15.00) DOLLARS and costs of prosecution as determined by a proper judicial authority.

Section 7: Any person violating Section 2 or Section 3 of this ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of THIRTY-FIVE (\$35.00) DOLLARS. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour, shall pay an

additional fine of \$2.00 per mile, for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit. In addition, any person convicted as aforesaid, shall pay the cost of prosecution as determined by a proper judicial authority.

Section 8: This ordinance shall become effective 1 September 1985.
