

TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS  
ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
ORDINANCE NO. 1-94

An Ordinance of the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, authorizing the adoption of the Kiski Valley Water Pollution Control Authority Resolution 1992-1 adopting the new, site-specific local discharge limits documented in the Local Limits Approval Request dated December 9, 1991, and a revision to the penalties for the violation of the Rules and Regulations governing industrial sewer use.

WHEREAS, the Township of Kiskiminetas and the Borough of East Vandergrift, Hyde Park, Leechburg, North Apollo, Oklahoma, Vandergrift, Apollo, and West Leechburg and the Townships of Allegheny, Gilpin, Parks, and Washington (hereinafter referred to as the "Municipalities") duly organized and incorporated the Kiski Valley Water Pollution Control Authority pursuant to the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, approved May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as amended, for the purpose, among other things, of acquiring, holding, construction, improving, maintaining, operating, and owning sewers, sewer systems, and sewage treatment works to serve the Township, the Municipalities, and other customers in the service area of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority owns and operates a wastewater treatment system which is permitted by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Environmental Resources; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has adopted a resolution revising the site-specific local discharge limits documented in the Local Limits Approval Request dated December 1991; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Municipalities have entered into a service agreement with the Authority dated July 1, 1973, whereby the Authority agrees to accept and treat wastewater discharges from the Township and the Municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to continue to utilize the Authority's wastewater treatment system and recognizes its industrial waste control obligations under the Federal General Pretreatment Regulations (40 CFR, Part 403); and

SECTION 1. The Township of Kiskiminetas shall adopt the revised local discharge limits as adopted by the Kiski Valley Water Pollution Control Authority, substantially in the form of Resolution 1992-1 which was presented at this meeting and is made a part hereof by reference only and is on file with the Township Secretary.

SECTION 2. No person shall contribute, cause to be contributed, or discharge any industrial wastes to the public sanitary sewage facilities of the Kiski Valley Water Pollution Control Authority, except in accordance with the Rules and Regulations Governing Industrial Sewer Use that have been adopted, or may hereafter be adopted, by the Authority.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance or resolution or part of any ordinance or resolution inconsistent or in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 4. Any person who is found to have violated or willfully or negligently fails to comply with any provision of the Rules and Regulations Governing Industrial Sewer Use adopted by the Authority or any order, regulation, service contract, or permit issued by the Authority, shall, upon conviction, be subject to pay a fine of not less than \$1,000 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than 30 days. Each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. If any provision, paragraph, word, or section of this ordinance shall be invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, and sections shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Kiski Valley Water Pollution Control Authority has requested and been granted preliminary approval by the U.S. EPA to revise the site-specific discharge limits as they relate to the Kiski Valley Water Pollution Control Authority's industrial pretreatment program in accordance with the Federal General Pretreatment Regulation (40 CFR, Part 403).

In order to facilitate the process of final approval of the local limits standards, the Authority has prepared a draft ordinance authorizing your municipality to adopt the resolution passed by the Authority. A copy of the draft ordinance is enclosed for your review and use.

Please have your solicitor review this document and initiate the required procedures to adopt the ordinance authorizing the municipality to adopt the local limits standards. Once similar ordinances have been passed by the various municipalities involved, copies of the respective ordinance will be forwarded to EPA. The authority will reimburse the municipality for the advertising costs associated with the adoption of this ordinance.
