

ORDINANCE NO. 2-71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS,
ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING PARTS
OF STATE LEGISLATIVE ROUTES 03167 and 03043,
ALL WITHIN THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID TOWNSHIP.

The Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, under the authority of "The Second Class Township Code" of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, as amended, does enact and ordain as follows:

Section 1. All those parts and portions of State Legislative Routes 03167 and 03043, all being within the jurisdictional boundary limits of Kiskiminetas Township, described as follows:

Legislative Route 03167: from a point at Station 4+11 to a point at Station 8+90, a distance of approximately 479 feet or approximately .0908 of a mile.

Legislative Route 03043: from a point at Station 279+10 to a point at Station 284+00, a distance of approximately 490 feet, or approximately .0928 of a mile; and also from a point at Station 289+80 to a point at Station 301+70, a distance of approximately 1,190 feet or approximately .2253 of a mile; and also from a point at Station 305+00 to a point at Station 308+00, a distance of approximately 300 feet or approximately .0568 of a mile.

shall be and the same is hereby vacated. This vacation is made by reason of the relocation of said parts of said roads and their subsequent abandonment by the Commonwealth as a part of the State Highway system; said abandoned parts of said roads being useless, burdensome and unnecessary for public convenience.
