

ORDINANCE NO. 2-75

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PRESCRIBING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ON A SECTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD NO. 329 AND ON A SECTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD NO. 460 AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same.

Section 1. The following sections of Township Roads are established as one-way traffic roads:

(a) Part of Township Road No. 329 shall be one-way traffic east for a distance of approximately four tenths (0.4) miles from its intersection with Township Road No. 460 east to its intersection with Legislative Route No. 03043.

(b) Part of Township Road No. 460 shall be one-way traffic southwest for a distance of approximately five tenths (0.5) miles from its intersection with Legislative Route No. 03043 southwest to its intersection with Township Road No. 329.

Section 2. Any person who shall operate a vehicle on said sections of said Township roads established as one-way traffic roads, other than in the direction established hereby for vehicular traffic thereon, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$10.00 and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, imprisonment not to exceed five (5) days.
