

ORDINANCE NO. 2-77

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING CERTAIN ROADS AND STREETS COMPLETELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF KISKIMINETAS TOWNSHIP, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS PART OF THE STREET AND ROAD SYSTEM OF SAID TOWNSHIP.

The Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township hereby enact and ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following described streets and roads are hereby laid out, opened and ordained as public streets and roads in the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania:

- (a) All those certain roads or streets known as Highland Avenue, from its intersection with Lincoln Avenue to its intersection with Washington Avenue, being a 50-foot wide street, and all of Knox Avenue, being a 40-foot street, which ends in a cul-de-sac, as shown on the Warren Heights Plan of Lots recorded in Armstrong County Plan Book Volume 3, Page 27. This Highland Avenue has since been renamed East Highland Drive.
- (b) All that certain street or road known as Meadow Street, being a 30-foot wide street, running from Highland Avenue in a westerly direction to Isabella Avenue, for a distance of 232 feet, as shown in the Grandview Plan of Lots recorded in Armstrong County Plan Book Volume 1, Page 151.
- (c) All of Laurel Way, running from Maple Drive to, but not including, the cul-de-sac, and all of Locust Circle including the cul-de-sac, both being 50-foot wide streets, as shown on the Deerwood Manor Plan of Lots recorded in Armstrong County Plan Book Volume 3, Pages 136-137 and 154-155.

Section 2. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to petitions filed by property owners abutting said streets and roads, and in the judgment of the Supervisors the adoption of said streets and roads as part of the street and road system of the said Township is necessary in the interest of public convenience.

Section 3. The said streets and roads are completely within the boundary limits of said Township, and the same shall become a part of the system of streets and roads of said Township.
