

ORDINANCE NO. 2-82

"AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING CERTAIN
ROADS AND STREETS COMPLETELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARY LIMITS
OF KISKIMINETAS TOWNSHIP, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AS PART OF THE STREET AND ROAD SYSTEM OF SAID TOWNSHIP."

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township has received petitions from all or a majority in interest of the owners of properties abutting the roads hereinafter set forth, requesting the said Supervisors to take over and adopt said roads into the Township road system;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The following described streets and roads are hereby laid out, opened and ordained as public streets and roads in the Township of Kiskiminetas, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania:

a. The road or street located in the Village of Edmon, being a total of 33.00 feet wide and extending 16.5 feet on each side of the centerline, which is more particularly bounded and described as shown on Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; said road is more commonly known as T-345.

b. The road or street located in the Village of Edmon, being a total of 33.00 feet wide and extending 16.5 feet on each side of the centerline,

which is more particularly bounded and described as shown on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; said road is more commonly known as T-345.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is adopted pursuant to petitions filed by property owners abutting said streets and roads, and in the judgment of the Supervisors, the adoption of said streets and roads as part of the street and road system of the said Township is necessary in the interest of public convenience.

SECTION 3: The said streets and roads are completely within the boundary limits of Kiskiminetas Township and the same shall become a part of the system of streets and roads of said Township.

SECTION 4: A certified copy of this ordinance, together with a release of damages signed by all abutting property owners and a survey or draft of each road shall be filed in the Office of the Prothonotary of Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and indexed in the miscellaneous docket.

SECTION 5: In the event that any of the roads aforesaid are not accepted as part of the Township roads system by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, the Board of Supervisors will begin proceedings to vacate said road or roads.
