

ORDINANCE NO. 2-86

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE KISKIMINETAS TOWNSHIP PER CAPITA TAX ORDINANCE NO. 4-53.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, desire to reduce the age for payment of the Township's per capita tax from twenty-one (21) years of age to eighteen (18) years of age.

THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kiskiminetas, County of Armstrong and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same:

1. Section 1 of Township Ordinance No. 4-53 and Township Resolution 2-53 is amended to change the age at which township residents are required to pay the per capita tax from twenty-one (21) years of age to eighteen (18) years of age.

2. This ordinance shall become effective in five (5) days from the date hereof.
