Ordinance No. 3 -69

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FIRE HYDRANT DISTRICTS ALONG CERTAIN HIGHWAYS, STREETS, ROADS AND ALLEYS IN THE TOWNSHIP; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A FIRE HYDRANT RENTAL AGREEMENT WITH KISKIMINETAS TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT OF THE COSTS THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SAID ASSESSMENTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 702-III of the Second Class Township Code, as amended, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kiskiminetas is empowered to enter into an agreement with municipal authorities for the placing, operation and maintenance of fire hydrants upon water mains maintaining pressures approved by the fire insurance underwriters along its highways, streets, roads and alleys; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kiskiminetas has determined that it would be in the best interests of the benefiting property owners that fire hydrant service be provided them; and

WHEREAS, Kiskiminetas Township Municipal Authority has agreed to enter into a Fire Hydrant Rental Agreement with the Township of Kiskiminetas to provide, among other things, for a water supply system that is equipped to supply sufficient water for the protection of property from fire and to place and connect fire hydrants on its lines along certain highways, streets, roads or alleys of the Township, all in accordance with the plans and specifications for the portion of its water project to be constructed in Kiskiminetas Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kiskiminetas, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Fire Hydrant Rental Agreement, dated as of October 1, 1969, with Kiskiminetas Township Municipal Authority applicable to fire hydrants service to be provided in the Township which was read in full at this meeting, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The said Agreement shall be executed for and on behalf of the Township of Kiskiminetas by the Chairman of its Board of Supervisors, attested by the Secretary of said Board, and the seal of the Township shall be affixed thereto.

SECTION 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs that the Township pay annually to Kiskiminetas Township Municipal Authority the annual rental set forth in said Agreement for each fire hydrant installed by the Authority and rendering fire hydrant service in the area of the Township served by the Authority's Water System. These payments shall be made in accordance with the said Agreement until the entire indebtedness of the Authority now existing or hereafter created for its water supply facilities and distribution system shall be fully paid and satisfied.

SECTION 4. The said payments under said Agreement shall be paid from annual assessments for fire hydrant service made by the Township under the assessment for county purposes method or the front foot assessment method, the procedure to be selected by the Board of Supervisors, as set forth in the Second Class Township Code.

SECTION 5. All such assessments for fire hydrant service shall be collected in the same manner as taxes. The Tax Collector shall receive the same commission as on the Township Tax. The Township Treasurer shall receive all such assessments collected for fire hydrant service and keep the same in a separate account and pay the same out only upon orders signed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, attested by the Secretary. The Township Treasurer shall make a report to the Auditors of the Township annually.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or resolutions not in accord with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they affect this Ordinance.
