

ORDINANCE NO. 3-77

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KISKIMINETAS, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES WITH WEIGHT AND LOAD EXCEEDING A CERTAIN GROSS WEIGHT, ON TOWNSHIP ROAD NO. 486 ALSO KNOWN AS FLORIDA AVENUE IN THE ORCHARD HILLS PLAN, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, in order to protect the aforesaid Township road, for the maintenance of which the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kiskiminetas, County of Armstrong and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, is responsible, and to insure the safety of traffic thereon, it is necessary to prohibit the operation on said Township road of motor vehicles with aggregate weight and load in excess of the gross weight hereinafter set forth.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of same.

Section 1. After proper official signs have been placed, as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle, truck, tractor, trailer or semi-trailer, or combination thereof, with an aggregate weight and load in excess of a gross weight of Seven (7) tons, except for local delivery upon Township road No. 486, also known as Florida Avenue between State Route LR03097 and State Route LR03166.

Section 2. The proper Township authorities are hereby directed to place official signs notifying the travelling public of the foregoing

weight restrictions on Township road No. 686, also known as Florida Avenue, as its intersection with State Route LR03097 and State Route LR03166.

Section 3. Any person who shall operate any motor vehicle, truck, tractor, trailer or semi-trailer, or any combination thereof, with an aggregate weight and load in excess of a gross weight of Seven (7) tons on Township road No. 486, also known as Florida Avenue, between State Route LR03097 and State Route LR03166, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$100 and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, imprisonment not to exceed ten (10) days.
