AN ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION

Of the Board of Supervisors of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, to provide for public safety and travel upon the public roads and highways in said township by designating speed limits on certain designated sections thereof by proper signs posted in and along the same; specifying the wording for said signs; and fixing penalties for the violation hereof.

Whereas, the welfare and safety of the users of public roads and highways in the Township of Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and also the property of such users, are frequently endangered by reckless driving and excessive speed at which vehicles are driven upon said highways;

Therefore, the Board of Supervisors of said Kiskiminetas Township, Armstrong County, Pa., enacts as follows:-

Section 1- Upon such public roads and highways within the said Township of Kiskiminetas, or sections thereof, as said Board of Supervisors may designate from time to time hereafter, the said Board shall erect or cause to be erected and placed proper signs to regulate and control the speed of vehicles using said highways, the same to be placed on the righthand side of the lane of traffic. On the side of said sign, facing traffic, shall be printed the words, "SPEED LIMIT _____ MILES PER HOUR" and at the end of the section of the road whereon traffic is to be controlled another sign shall be erected containing the words "END OF SPEED LIMIT". Said signs shall be so placed as to be easily seen by on-coming traffic, and the lettering shall be of such size as to be readily legible.

Section 2- On highways under the control or partially under the control of the State Highway Department, consent of said Department to the erection of said signs shall be secured, if necessary.

Section 3- Any violation of this Ordinance or Resolution shall subject the offender to arrest, and upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$10.00 and costs of suit, in a summary proceeding before any Justice of the Peace of the County of Armstrong, Penn'a; and upon default in the payment of said fine and costs, the offender may be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding ten days.
