## ORDINANCE No.8-55

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF KISKIMINETAS TOWNSHIP, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Prohibiting the operation on all township highways, roads, or bridges of vehicles with weight and load exceeding a certain gross weight, and providing penalties.

WHEREAS, in order to protect the Township highways, roads, and bridges, for the maintenance of which the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kiskiminetas, County of Armstrong, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, is responsible, and to insure the safety of traffic thereon, it is necessary to prohibit the operation on such highways, roads, or bridges of motor vehicles with aggregate weight and load in excess of the gross weight hereinafter set forth.

NOW, Therefore, pursuant to the authority conferred upon Second Class Townships by Section 1101 of the Act of May 1, 1929, P.L. 905, as amended, and Section 702, Subsection XLI of the Act of July 10, 1947, P.L. 1481, as amended, the Board of Supervisors of such Township does hereby enact and ordain that:

Section 1. After proper official signs have been placed, as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate upon the township highways, roads, or oridges any motor vehicle, truck, tractor, trailer or semi-trailer, or combination thereof, with an aggregate weight and load in excess of the gross weight of Seven (7) tons.

Section 2. The proper township authorities are hereby directed to place official signs notifying the traveling public of the foregoing weight restrictions on the township highways, roads, or bridges at their intersections with highways on which heavier gross weights or loads are permitted.

Section 3. Any person refusing to unload excess weight when so ordered by a peace officer in uniform, or violating any of the provisions of the ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before a justice of the peace, be sentenced to pay a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) and cost of prosecution and in default of the payment thereof shall undergo imprisionment for not more than five (5) days.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect November 10, 1955.
