June 10, 2026

Regular Meeting Minutes

Chairman Bob Ross called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: H. Ross, M. Long, B. Hilliard, T. Tardivo, A. Birch, Austin Keppis from LSSE, Solicitor Fritz, Sgt Tessmer, and Interim Twp Manager Jason Dailey.

Motion by M. Long seconded by A. Birch approve Minutes from the May Regular and Workshop Meetings. Motion carried.

Motion by M. Long Seconded by A. Birch to approve the May Treasurers Reports. Motion carried.

Motion by A. Birch Seconded by M. Long approve the May Payable Voucher Lists. Motion carried.

Solicitor Fritz reported on work being done on two parcels related to their title searches.

Austin Keppis for the Engineer discussed work done on Sawyer Ln stormwater review,

Interim Township Manager Jason Dailey reported that bids were accepted and opened for stone, fuel and chip seal, the 2025 audit information was collected and is ready for the audit to begin, numerous complaints received on side by side.

Motion by M. Long, Seconded by A. Birch to approve the purchase of new police radios with \$9,000 paid from the general fund and the balance from the asset forfeiture fund. Motion carried.
